Message Recap

Jesus didn't come to start a religion. He came for a different reason...relationship. He came to lead us into a growing relationship with God. Ultimately, so that he can transform us into everything God created us to be. And that happens by us taking one next step at a time.

Main Point

Our relationship with God grows by following Jesus one next step at a time.

Questions for Reflection

 - Obeying the promptings from the Holy Spirit.
- 5. What will you explore next? If you haven't put your faith in Jesus, what's stopping you?
