T-Life Group Values and Goals

Availability

And if there comes a time when a member needs to step out of this group, simply let the leader know. It's okay!

Authenticity

The atmosphere of a T-Life Group should encourage authenticity, openness, and transparency among members, where people can feel free to be themselves no matter the past, present, or future. In a world where most things seem counterfeit, we strive for authenticity. Simply put, just be real.

Confidentiality

For authenticity to occur, members must also be able to trust that things or issues discussed within the group will not be shared with anyone outside the group. When trust is broken, relationships suffer. We protect one another in this way.

Respect

First, we listen to and respect the input from every member as we pursue a transformed life together. When we don't understand something, we turn to the truth of scripture and work to help one another along on our spiritual journey. Second, group members should never say anything that will embarrass any other person in the group, including their friend or spouse. Avoiding passive comments and sarcasm are great ways to respect and protect one another as well.

Invitation

In order for as many people to experience community, there may be times when we need to invite someone into this group. Although this group is a closed group, the group can determine together when a personal invitation is necessary. "Reaching One" by Investing and inviting is how the Kingdom grows too.
